

Correction numération exercice 4 – CM2

$$\frac{533}{100} = \frac{500}{100} + \frac{30}{100} + \frac{3}{100} = 5 + \frac{3}{10} + \frac{3}{100}$$

$$\frac{642}{100} = \frac{600}{100} + \frac{40}{100} + \frac{2}{100} = 6 + \frac{4}{10} + \frac{2}{100}$$

$$\frac{973}{100} = \frac{900}{100} + \frac{70}{100} + \frac{3}{100} = 9 + \frac{7}{10} + \frac{3}{100}$$

$$\frac{856}{100} = \frac{800}{100} + \frac{50}{100} + \frac{6}{100} = 8 + \frac{5}{10} + \frac{6}{100}$$

$$\frac{3\,051}{1\,000} = \frac{3\,000}{1\,000} + \frac{50}{1\,000} + \frac{1}{1\,000} = 3 + \frac{5}{100} + \frac{1}{1\,000}$$

$$\frac{7\,564}{1\,000} = \frac{7\,000}{1\,000} + \frac{500}{1\,000} + \frac{60}{1\,000} + \frac{4}{1\,000} = 7 + \frac{5}{10} + \frac{6}{100} + \frac{4}{1\,000}$$
